Footnotes

SKIP SCHOOL made a slim lead down the backstretch, edged clear on the turn, drifted out some into the stretch then lasted in a strong drive. LISASFRIENDLYLOVER pressed the pace, was carried out some into the stretch, had every opportunity and finished well. BENNINGTON saved ground, rallied four wide around the turn and finished strongly. CHARLOMAINE gained a clear lead early, kept pace along the backstretch, weakened in the drive. COLD TOES forced the pace three and four wide, lacked a late response. MICMACEUSE saved ground to no avail. CASE SAID showed little five wide. MISS HOLY MOLY was no factor inside. SHAKESPEARE CRITIC broke down into the turn. The rider of LISASFRIENDLYLOVER claimed foul against the winner alleging interference in the stretch. The Stewards reviewed the video tape replays but saw no reason to take action and allowed the original order of finish to stand.
