HEY DOC HOLIDAY prompted the pace from the rail, angled four wide for the drive, drew off under a strong drive. WILLEM pressed the issue three wide, drew on even terms in the stretch but was out finished. SECOND TO NONE set the pace from the inside, dug in around the turn, weakened the last sixteenth. ABU RACER within striking distance three wide, lacked a late response. COPPER RIVER off the pace four wide, lacked the needed rally. STORM CAT VALAY failed to menace on the rail. SMOKIN CANOE up close early while three wide, steadily fell back. MAGIC E. T. flashed brief foot four wide then was not asked through the stretch. WILDREBELRUNNIN trailed throughout along the inside and was easing through the stretch.
