**Footnotes**

ENABLE stalked the leaders three and four wide, was set down for the drive and up in the final strides. LUXURY TAX forced the issue three wide, made a slim lead at the top of the stretch and led until the final strides. UNSHATTERABLE set the pace on the rail, dug in around the turn, missed in a game effort. LYCIAN pressed the issue just off the rail, lacked a closing bid. HEYHEARMEROAR advanced three and four wide, finished well. HEARTBREAK AFFAIR three wide along the backstretch, eased out five wide on the turn, finished with good energy. DIXIE THIEF prompted the pace three and four wide, lacked a late response. MOJAVE'S GOLD saved ground, swung out five wide around the turn, lacked the needed rally. VANDAS ANGEL made a strong run five wide around the turn, flattened out. MACKINAC made little impact, three and four wide.
