Footnotes

BURNT OFFERING sped to the front, set the pace along the rail, steadily increased his advantage and was under brisk whipping through the stretch. THEYCALLHIMMRBIGGS stalked the pace, saved ground around the far turn and was second best. BOBBLEY, three wide both turns, failed to menace the winner in a willing effort. QUATORZE ROYALTY, four wide the first turn, was in the two path on the far turn, eased out in upper stretch and failed to rally. SCARY STORM saved ground in an even effort. ROMAN CANDLE LIGHT lacked speed, circled the far turn, swung wide entering the stretch and passed tired rivals. MR. JIGGLES, well off the rail, was outrun. STERLING BLACKJACK chased the pace along the rail and faltered on the far turn. STORMIN HEDGES, outrun, was pulled up in midstretch.
