Footnotes

SKIP TO THE NORTH with the pace just off the rail, gained a slim lead down the backstretch, drew off under a drive. OTTOWISE advanced four wide and was clearly second best. DEVIL'S DREAM with the leaders along the inside, remained a factor on the turn but was no match for the top two in the drive. BODIDDLE saved ground, eased out three wide on the turn, lacked a late response. TACTICAL ASSAULT never threatened five wide. TEA TOTT alternated for the lead from the rail, was three wide down the backstretch, had little left for the drive. RICH DISCOVERY within striking distance on the rail, failed to respond. SOCIAL CODE never was a factor, three and four wide. MAXIMUM SECURITY was used up after a half, four and five wide. WAVE ME BY stopped after a half, three wide.
