Footnotes

BLUES IN THE NIGHT , two wide the first turn, advanced in the three path on the far turn, gained a clear lead in upper stretch, drifted out near the sixteenth pole and lasted under brisk urging. MISTER BRASS saved ground on the first turn, raced in the three path turning for home and rallied despite drifting in inside the sixteenth pole. DARTH TATER set the pace along the rail and weakened through the stretch. JOYFUL KISS , three wide entering the first turn, prompted the pace outside DARTH TATER and gave way entering the stretch. A. P. BEST , very wide entering the stretch, passed tired horses. SPEEDY TUXEDO was outrun. DOC'S DANCER was outrun. REGAL COMPANY , off the rail, chased the pace two the far turn, gave way and drifted wide entering the stretch.
