SAME OLD LINE was shut off soon after the start, made steady progress three wide, swept to command in upper stretch and drew off under a drive. PEARL CITY GIRL chased the pace two wide and finished willingly to gain the place. CUT HER IN bumped with TURCKSTERS DANCE just after the start, was forced in leaving the chute, saved ground and rallied for the show. MISS MADDIE BEE angled in sharply soon after the start, putting several rivals in tight, sprinted clear to set the pace along the rail and weakened in the lane. TRUCKSTERS DANCE bumped with CUT HER IN just after the start, was forced to check off that rivals heels when MISS MADDIE BEE angled over sharply leaving the chute, raced three and four wide around the turn and rallied belatedly. IS THAT BLUE failed to menace while racing three wide. IMPERIAL CHARM was sluggish into stride and outrun well off the rail. WILD COTTON tired inside.
