Footnotes

BLUES IN THE NIGHT settled just off the early pace about the four path, bid toward the five sixteenths pole, dueled to the front nearing the top of the stretch, drew clear a sixteenth away and held well with steady handling. CELESTIAL FIELDS, four wide the opening turn, rated close three wide, dueled to a brief slim lead mid turn but yielded to the winner at the head of the lane and had to settle for place. FREUDS ANA STREAK stalked the early pace two deep, moved to the front near the five sixteenths pole and held the advantage to mid turn but quickly gave back control and leveled off through the lane. GOLD RAPTOR rated well back from the early pace off the rail, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, angled five wide while improving through the final turn but had little left in the stretch. MISTER FIPS (IRE) settled off the pace inside, made a mild bid off the rail nearing the quarter pole though showed little further in the stretch. ALL FOR PEACE saved ground while giving chase and loomed a close factor through the backstretch before fading. JUST ASK DADDY ducked out a path causing the rider to lose an iron and nearly became unseated into the first turn, then, never factored. HE'S THE KING hustled to the lead early, showed the way most of the backstretch, was caught nearing the five sixteenths pole and continued to give chase another pole before fading. WILD INQUIRY was through early.
