Footnotes

SUPER BRILLIANT made a clear lead early, widened around the turn then was ridden out through the stretch. STAR JUBILEE closest to the winner throughout on the inside, could not gain on the winner while clearly second best. LEFT HAND LANE prompted the pace just off the rail, lacked a late response. TRUCULENT WONDER ducked in and bumped with CAT PLAYER at the start, forced the pace four wide, dropped to the rail on the turn then had no late bid. DANDY TOPPER stalked the pace four and five wide, failed to respond. WHEREAS LIGHTNING failed to menace, three and four wide. NAPOLEON J three wide along the backstretch, angled to the rail around the turn and was no threat in the drive. CAT PLAYER lunged at the start and was bumped, and squeezed back, showed little. KEY FORCE never was a factor inside. SLEWCINO bore out and bumped with CAT PLAYER at the start then had little impact.
