Footnotes

KING LEOPOLD prompted the issue three wide, gained the lead on the turn, drew off the last sixteenth. GREAT LOVE bore in and bumped with POWER IN TRUTH at the start, set the pace then was all out to hold second. MISTER FIPS (IRE) forced the issue from the inside, finished well. MONEY ISSUES three wide down the backstretch, rallied around the turn, closed with a rush. MONEY TO BURN pressed the issue just off the rail, lacked a late response. OUT OF OUR MINE stumbled just after the start, was off the pace three and four wide, finished strongly. LEVITE saved ground, rallied four wide on the turn, finished fastest of all. GLORIOUS SUNRISE three and four wide, lacked the needed rally. IM A TIGGER TOO bore out and bumped with POWER IN TRUTH at the start, never threatened on the rail. POWER IN TRUTH bumped from both sides at the start, was five wide around the first turn while making little impact.
