GOOLAGONG pressed the issue three and four wide, gained the lead in deep stretch. THE URUGAUCHA saved ground, rallied four wide on the turn, finished strongly. WHERE'S MY CANDY set the pace from the inside, dug in around the turn, led until deep stretch. ABBY KALEM bumped at the start, moved up on the rail, closed with a rush. SAINT LARA stalked the leaders four and five wide, finished well. FULL OF LOVE bore out and bumped with ABBY KALEM at the start, forced the pace three wide, lacked a late bid. SULTRY GIBSON prompted the pace along the inside, lacked a closing bid. COLLEGE STATION tardy at the start, was five wide down the backstretch, eased down three wide on the turn, finished willingly. TWIST TIME TONI broke in a tangle then was no factor from the inside.
