HAITIAN NATION settled off the early pace along the rail, advanced inside into the far turn, lacked room around that bend, split horses three wide in upper stretch, seized command inside the sixteenth pole and dug in gamely to deny the runner-up. NAVY CHAPEL settled off the pace while racing two wide, advanced four wide around the far turn, rallied outside through the lane and was turned back by the winner late. MISS BESS was unhurried while racing two wide early, continued two wide around the far turn, rallied and was just up for the show in the final strides. MISSY KIM stalked the pace two wide, reached even terms near the quarter pole, vied two deep rounding the far turn, led past the sixteenth pole and weakened late. D D'S DESTINY failed to menace while racing three wide. FEISTY ANGELINA set the pace along the rail, vied inside around the far turn and tired in the lane. SWEET WALK saved ground to no avail. GETTIN OUT QUICK steadied off heels early and was no threat while racing three and four wide. SECRET STORM stumbled at the start and trailed.
