DARK CONTESSA saved ground, rallied five wide around the turn but was too late. HANAIEI BAY forced the issue three and four wide, lacked a late response. STORM A BREWING set the pace on the rail, gave way in the drive. CABER'S CUTIE never threatened, three and four wide. BLUES CAT stopped after half, three wide.
