Footnotes

GENTLEMAN JOHN rated close off the rail, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, dug in for the lead between horses late stretch and lasted well. RASCAL CAT, off the pace and off the rail, bid past the three eighths pole, was outfinished for the win but up late for place. ROYAL ZONE rated a short lead inside, was pressured leaving the five sixteenths pole and dug in with control to late stretch before reluctantly ceding. WINDSOR'S SECRET, four wide the opening turn, saved ground approaching the final turn, was under a drive at the quarter pole and finished evenly. FIRST AND BAY rounded the opening turn three wide while off the early pace, gave chase from the seven sixteenths pole but had nothing further on the final turn. DELAWARE DIAMOND, SPEEDY TUXEDO and AIR WOLF were all well back and not factors.
