Footnotes

TAKEN rated a short lead off the rail, was pressured nearing the quarter pole, contested the advantage through the final turn and dug in determinedly to ward off the efforts of the runner-up. SIR SILVER FOX stalked the pace about the three path, took aim nearing the quarter pole, dueled a close turn factor but drifted out entering the stretch and couldn't get by the winner. THREE POINT TICKET, well back off the rail, started a bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, improved his position in the three path of the final turn and finished evenly. GOLDEN HALL kept close to the pace toward mid track, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole and raced evenly through the lane. TYLER'S JEWEL raced well back from the early pace toward the inside then bid mildly off the rail through the final turn. PATROL LEADER, crowded early, was outrun toward the outside. MOLINARO HONOR came away awkwardly, chased the leaders from the inside then weakened through the stretch. FLATWOOD HANK was five wide the opening turn and never a factor. UNBRIDLED FOX saved ground and was through early.
