HIT A HOMER set the pace on the rail, dug in stretch, held clear under a drive. BAY BUTTON BILL prompted the issue just off the rail, was slowly gaining in the drive. PANTASTIC moved up three and four wide, finished strongly. FORT SEATTLE four wide backstretch, rallied seven wide on the turn, closed with a rush. JAZZ SEEKER off the pace three wide, closing ground at the end. WILPONI well placed inside, finished with good energy. FORT APACHE STAR in tight after the start, was four and five wide, lacked a closing bid. THEYCALLMEJOHNNY G saved ground but had no rally. SUPER SAINTNICK with the leaders just off the rail, was used up after a half.
