Footnotes

CAPTAIN TEN stalked the pace from the rail, edged closer four wide around the far turn, slowly gained through the stretch and was up in the final strides. BANNER TIME pressed the pace two wide between rivals around the first turn, took the lead near the three-eighths pole, set the pace in the two path around the far turn, drifted in and bothered BEE REGAL near the sixteenth pole and led until the final strides. SILVER PIONEER was unhurried inside early, advanced five wide around the far turn and finished well to gain the show. BEE REGAL lacked speed along the rail, moved up along the rail around the far turn, bid inside nearing the sixteenth pole, was forced to check when BANNER TIME came in near the sixteenth pole and lacked room through the rest of the stretch drive. THUNDERELLO DANCER was loose pre-race, set the pace along the rail, dropped back nearing the far turn, angled three wide to re-bid between rivals leaving the three-sixteenths pole, continued on his left lead in the lane and was outfinished. BROOKS IN TOWN failed to menace while racing three wide. SIGNATURE RUN was no threat while racing four wide. BILLY'S BLESSING stalked the pace three wide and tired nearing the lane. A. P. BEST was outrun while racing three wide early and six wide around the far turn. SIGNAL FLAG was outrun while racing five wide. Following an inquiry and an objection from the rider of BEE REGAL, BANNER TIME was disqualified and placed fourth for interference in midstretch.
