Footnotes

HEY U was bumped just after the start, quickly recovered to sprint clear down the backstretch, set the pace along the rail around the turn and lasted under a steady drive through the lane. DESAFINADO BAY chased the pace in the two path, advanced outside of the winner around the turn, dropped back while drifting five wide turning for home then finished well through the lane to be steadily gaining on the winner. HAPPY MINSTRAL saved ground down the backstretch, gained on the leaders while racing in the two path around the turn, stayed inside in the lane and finished willingly. A SHOT AND A MINT gained on the leaders while racing four wide around the turn and finished well outside. WAY POINT bumped with PRINCESS LUCY just after the start, raced five wide around the turn and rallied mildly through the lane. PETULANT came out and bumped the winner just after the start, saved ground and never threatened. WILL'S PRESENCE was off slow, moved up three wide around the turn and lacked the needed stretch rally. RICH MARCHESA failed to menace while racing two wide. PRINCESS LUCY bumped with WAY POINT just after the start and never factored thereafter while racing in the two path. FANCY WHEELS raced five and six wide around the turn, dropped back and lugged in under right-handed urging in the stretch.
