BLUSHING B. J. advanced three wide, bid around the turn then in a long drive was up in the final strides. HOT SAUCE prompted the issue three wide, angled to the rail gaining the lead on the turn, led until the final strides. BUCKLE BUNNY BABE forced the pace four wide, dropped to the inside around the turn, loomed but hung in the drive. COUNT YOUR PENNIES moved up along the rail, angled out for the drive, failed to sustain her bid. AMPLE OPPORTUNITY stumbled at the start, saved ground, lacked a late response. MY GIRL JULES crowded soon after the start, saved ground to no avail. COZY AT MIDNIGHT a pace four and five wide, lacked the needed rally. PRIZE OF PROSPECT was used up after a half, three and four wide. IDEAL THOUGHTS set the early pace, had little left after a half. LIL MISS JANE alternated for the lead just off the rail, stopped after a half.
