Footnotes

SING THE BLUES chased the early pace about the three path, dueled to the front midstretch and edged clear in later yards. FRUGAL LOUISE chased the pace off the rail, raced at even terms between horses midstretch, gave way to the winner at that point and just lasted in place. CRAFTWELL'S BELLE gave distant chase from the outside, rounded the turn six wide, steadily improved throughout and just missed second. SILKEN LIZZIE flipped in the paddock, angled in with a clear lead to set the pace inside, yielded the advantage midstretch and weakened from there. PERSNICKITY chased the pace about the four path then lugged inward while leveling off through the upper stretch. MADHUBALA drifted out on the chute, chased the pace off the rail and finished evenly. BLUSHING DAMSEL gave chase to the head of the lane before fading. FULL CIRCLE gave distant chase inside. SUAVE SWINGER drifted in on the chute and was not a factor. E. T. ECHO was pinched back on the chute then no factor.
