Footnotes

CASH OR CHEQUE accelerated to the front at the seven sixteenths pole, was pressured into the turn and held well with steady encouragement. BROWNSTONE chased the early pace toward the outside, drifted inward nearing the three eighths pole, saved more ground on the turn, finished evenly and settled for second best. GABBI'S AMOR, well back outside, started a drive at the quarter pole, saved some ground through the turn and finished evenly. TRI OMEGA chased the early pace inside, lost ground through the turn and showed little further down the lane. GRIZZLY BAY chased the early pace toward mid track, was forced in nearing the three eighths pole, continued pursuit at the rail rounding the turn but leveled off in the stretch. WHEELING FEELING briefly clear on the chute, set a pressured pace the opening furlong, gave chase past the seven sixteenths pole, saved ground on the turn then weakened in the stretch. INTERNATIONAL GUY gave chase from the inside though never factored. MONEY DRIVE stumbled badly at the start. USURPER was bumped and squeezed nearing the three eighths pole, moved to the inside approaching the turn then broke down midway through the turn.
