Footnotes

SANDRO PAZZO bumped with ACROSS THE WIND early, prompted the pace three wide around the first turn, took command at the five-sixteenths pole, quickly drew clear around the far turn, drifted five wide into the lane and held clear under a steady drive. INTO THE NIGHT stalked the pace five wide around the first turn, advanced outside down the backstretch, chased the winner while still four wide around the far turn, came six wide into the lane and finished evenly. DEVIL'S HALL stalked the pace inside, could not match strides with the top two in upper stretch but held third. SEASONALITY raced in the two path around the first turn, advanced outside down the backstretch, was four wide around the far turn and lacked a closing bid. UNBRIDLED BATTLE set the pace in the two path, was collared at the five-sixteenths pole and tired around the far turn. ACROSS THE WIND stumbled just after the start, was bounced around between SANDRO PAZZO and MAKINUSFAMOUS soon after, dropped back two wide around the first turn, continued to drop back down the backstretch, raced three wide around the far turn, angled in at the head of the lane, rallied inside, angled out in midstretch and finished with interest. MAKINUSFAMOUS bumped with ACROSS THE WIND after the start and never threatened thereafter while racing three and four wide. MILLARD was off slow then failed to menace while racing three wide. KEEP ON DANCING flashed brief speed along the rail.
