ACHARI pressed the pace from the rail, gained the lead late on the turn, drew off through the stretch under a drive. HOSTILITY hopped at the start, moved up to prompt the pace three and four wide and was second best. LILIAS TROTTER angled down to set the pace just off the rail then was out finished. FRENCH REPUBLIC saved ground, came three wide around the turn, lacked a closing bid. MAC LADY showed early speed inside, tired.
