GET GLUED ON quickly made the lead, held clear around the turn then prevailed under strong urging. BACKBAR WITH TAMMY moved up three wide down the backstretch, finished well through the lane. TUFTIKUS advanced four wide to reach contention and finished strongly in the stretch. SWELZEL pressed the issue just off the rail and finished willingly. KNOBIE crowded soon after the start, was kept six and wide, failed to respond when asked. GOLDEN SWIRL sluggish then bumped at the start, never threatened. BOONE'S BABE broke in a tangle, rushed to contention but tired. FREEDOM IS GOLDEN six wide along the backstretch, angled to the rail on the turn, lacked the needed late rally. MICHAELS APPEAL off a step slow, flashed brief foot on the rail.
