MATTAPONI rated a clear lead inside, was under a drive leaving the final turn and held on under steady insistence. CAMMY MOUNTAIN settled back about the four path, bid nearing the three eighths pole, saved some ground past the five sixteenths, dueled for place midstretch, finished well and was gaining on the winner. SEEKTHE WILDLIGHT stalked the winner off the rail, gave chase from the five sixteenths pole, yielded place inside the sixteenth pole and leveled off late. R TAKELA kept off the pace inside, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole but leveled off rounding the final turn. ANTHENSOME raced well back toward mid track and finished evenly. DENALI PASSION settled back off the rail, started a bid nearing the three eighths pole but was shuffled back a pole later and weakened. MIDAS WELL and AVENEL were both well back and not factored. CALMING SEA, a step slow to break, moved toward contention five wide approaching the first turn, eased on the backstretch and was vanned home.
