GINGERBREAD FRED pressured the pace off the rail, took over nearing the quarter pole, dueled clear into the lane and determined to last. PARKERSDOUBLEDOTS kept close to the pace toward mid track, started a bid leaving the three eighths pole, took aim four wide through the turn, couldn't get by the winner though gamely tried. TIGI BROKE HIS VOW engaged in close early chase inside, was boxed at the heels of the pacesetter past the five sixteenths pole, lost momentum while apprehensively ridden behind a narrow opening at the head of the lane, eased out from there and finished well. GETAWAY MONEY stumbled leaving the gate, picked up the chase inside, eased out through the upper stretch but had little further. FREETO BANDITO was hustled to a brief clear lead after bobbling at the break, set a pressured pace inside to the quarter pole, gave chase from there then weakened from the head of the lane. INTERNATIONAL GUY gave chase from off the rail and had nothing left in the stretch. RUBEN TIPSTER raced well back inside. SHARPIE'S SON raced well back toward mid track.
