SILENT REVIVAL accelerated to the early lead, hugged the rail and was under pressure in the drive. CANUTA chased the pace two wide down the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, weakened and held the place. AFTERNOON GUY , three deep down the backstretch, chased the winner and weakened in the drive. HE'S GREAT saved ground on the turn and failed to menace. DIXIE GENT , two deep on the turn, failed to rally. SOLVE THE CODE came out a bit leaving the starting gate, raced between horses on the turn, swung wide in upper stretch and failed to be a factor. BROOKLYN LEGEND lacked speed, saved ground on the turn and was not a factor. CHUCKS TOOTHPICKS , steadied when pinched back leaving the starting gate, was outrun. MR. EGORE , wide leaving the turn, gave way. SALTY EMPEROR gave way.
