YES YOU WILL allowed to settle, slipped through inside of rivals in the stretch to prevail. MELEIUM unhurried early, launched a bid on the far turn, led briefly in the stretch but could not hold on. ANNIE UP contended throughout, was outfinished. TASMANIA MISS dictated the pace, weakened in the stretch. AMYGOTHERWAY raced midpack four wide, lacked the needed response. SIMCHA pressed the pace, gave way on the far turn. AMPLE'S STAR lagged well back, had no rally. SLIGHT K. O'S offered little. EDNA PEDNA through after a half mile and was not punished late when hopelessly beaten. CAROLINE'S CANDY clipped heels shortly after the start and unseated her rider. A Steward's Inquiry was posted after the finish of the race but did not result in any change to the original order of finish.
