MISS ATTICUS tracked the leader, made a strong bid with a quarter mile to run, poked her head in front, drifted out entering the stretch to lose the lead, came in slightly inside the eighth pole and prevailed. NASTY SABRINA allowed to settle, angled out upper stretch and rallied. DOLLY'S WAGER set the pace, dueled through the second turn, was headed then came again, drifted out slightly inside the furlong marker and was outfinished. SWEET MUSIC unhurried early, improved position. OLYMPIC NIGHT stalked the pace, closed the gap to the leaders through the second turn, loomed boldly upon reaching the stretch, tried to split rivals but was shut off and clipped heels nearly unseating her rider. JOLLY OPTIMIST checked sharply while very rank early, never was a threat. IN DEFIANCE off slowly, showed little. FOREVER IN LOVE saved ground to no avail. POWER OF FAITH close up to the backstretch, stopped. A Steward's Inquiry and Jockey's Objection were posted shortly after the finish of the race. After reviewing the video replays the Stewards ruled that for interference in the stretch that MISS ATTICUS be disqualified from first and placed fourth while DOLLY'S WAGER was disqualified and placed fifth.
