Footnotes

PLURACITY prompted the pace outside CHAC MOOL, sprinted clear leaving the backstretch, angled to the inner rail entering the far turn and was under energetic urging in the drive. VARBOROUGH, bumped by GOOD CHEMISTRY entering the first turn, was four deep on the bend, advanced four wide on the far turn and rallied. WHO WE GUNNA CALL lacked speed, hugged the rail on the far turn and in the stretch and rallied. DO THE MATH saved ground on the far turn and rallied mildly. GOOD CHEMISTRY came out and bumped VARBOROUGH entering the first turn, raced in the three path between horses, tried to get out on the far turn and came up empty in the drive. CHAC MOOL set the early pace along the rail, lost the lead entering the backstretch, eased out to the two path midway down the backstretch, chased the winner to the stretch then gave way. TISNOW JULIE lacked speed, swung wide entering the stretch and was not a factor. HOLD THAT BROAD chased the pace and faltered on the far turn.
