Footnotes

SAFE LANDING lacked speed, raced in the three path on the second and third turns, took command approaching the stretch and drew off while kept to his business. THE SPANISH LIFE , two wide on the final turn, swung outside in upper stretch and rallied. TEA TOTT prompted the pace well off the rail, gained the lead entering the final turn and weakened through the stretch. JAMES WOOD saved ground, chased the pace and weakened. STILL THE ONE , very wide entering the stretch, was not a threat. WISCONSIN was not a factor. KEEPASHARPLOKOUT , very wide turning for home, was outrun. MEDIA SPEED drifted wide leaving the first turn, set the pace off the rail, faltered leaving the final turn and was eased through the stretch. CALVIN B faltered and was eased through the stretch.
