EXPLOSIVE SQUALL settled back off the rail early, eased to the outside leaving the first turn, bid toward the five sixteenths pole, entered the stretch five wide, dueled to the front inside the sixteenth pole and inched clear under the wire. BLOSSOM'S GOLD rated with the pace two deep, gave chase from the three eighths pole, dueled to the front midway on the final turn, dug in with the advantage to the sixteenth pole, yielded to the winner and just lasted for place. EVENINGOFPLEASURE, pinched back after the start, rated back outside, bid nearing the three eighths pole, angled six wide leaving the final turn, finished well and was gaining on the runner-up. CITI DISPUTE, off the pace inside, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, had aim at the top of the stretch but leveled off the final sixteenth. GLENORIE settled close to the early pace inside, gave chase from the three eighths pole, took aim leaving the final turn but was bumped out a path and leveled off from there. CATCHPENNY LASS leapt from the gate, accelerated to contention four wide into the first turn, moved to the front past the half mile pole, rated that lead through the backstretch, was pressured nearing the quarter pole, caught midway on the final turn, came out a path making contact with Glenorie entering the stretch and weakened from there. EASTER RISING, well back off the rail, bid at the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn in the five path but showed little further down the lane. DID YOU KNOW rated close to the early pace three wide,

gave chase nearing the five sixteenths pole then weakened saving ground on the final turn. BOBJONCLAIRENALICE, off the pace inside, was through early. SEEK TO WIN came in after the start, rated a slim lead inside the opening turn, was caught past the half mile pole, gave chase to the five sixteenths pole then gave way from there.
