Footnotes

STORMY ACRE stalked the pace racing off the rail, was three wide leaving the far turn, closed outside the leader and was along in time. PURELY DETERMINED prompted the pace outside JACK ON THE ROCKS, gained the lead on the far turn and gave way grudgingly. CURLING ROCKS lacked speed, advanced between horses on the far turn, angled out for the drive and rallied. JACK ON THE ROCKS sprinted to the early lead, set the pace along the rail and weakened through the stretch. THAT'STHEQUESTION, along the rail leaving the backstretch, eased out on the turn and failed to rally. FUNNY ACCOMMODATION lacked speed and was not a factor. ZIP MY LIP raced along the rail on the far turn and weakened. CYBERTRON, three wide both turns, chased the pace and faltered.
