MALIBU KITTEN off the pace three and four wide, bid around the turn then was up in the final strides. SNUCK IN FOR FREE stalked the leaders three wide, finished strongly. LUYU with leaders three wide, finished well. HOUSEHUNTER pressed the issue just off the rail, held a slim lead at the top of the stretch and finished with good energy. FIVEFIFTYFIVE moved up four and five wide, finished willingly. PHARMTRIP set the pace on the rail, dug in around the turn, weakened the last sixteenth. WILD PEARL well placed inside, lacked a closing bid. DISCO DIVA was used up after a half along the inside. WATERSIDE ROSE broke in a tangle then steadied at the start, showed little four and five wide.
