Footnotes

BYJAX moved up three wide down the backstretch, gained a clear lead on the turn then under a strong drive was all out to last. COTTON HEARTED three wide down the backstretch, eased out five wide on the turn, came seven wide for the drive and finished strongly. SANTEE DEVIL advanced three and four wide, angled six wide for the drive and closed with a rush through the lane. THIRSTY GIANT bore out and steadied at the start, made a steady run three and four wide, lacked a late bid. SANDRO PAZZO tardy then bumped at the start, moved up along the inside then lacked a closing bid. OMEGA GLORY bore out and bumped with SANDRO PAZZO at the start, set the pace on the rail, weakened in the drive. QUIET I'M THINKING was no factor, four and five wide. HAPPY MOTHERS DAY flashed early speed on the rail, steadily faded. CIVIL DISTURBANCE pressed the pace just off the rail, tired.
