AARON'S WAY set the pace on the rail then in a long drive, was all out to last. FRED HIGH off a step slow then crowded at the start, moved up four wide and finished strongly. GOLDEN SET steadied after the start from in tight, was with the pace three wide, lacked a late bid. BANXIOUSFORNOTHING with the leaders four wide, lacked a late response. STRAWBERRY CUPCAKE checked off heels after the start, rallied around the turn along the inside, failed to sustain his bid. JUST YOUR WAY pressed the pace from the inside, gave way around the turn. TURF COUNT showed little, three wide. MISTER BRASS flashed brief foot along the inside. DI COLAS TOWN was used up after a half down on the inside. KING OF SCOTTLAND hit the gate at the start, had little left after a half three and four wide.
