Footnotes

BLACK BELT brushed with SON OF A BEAR just after the start, set a pressured pace in the two path, drew clear nearing the quarter pole, dug in gamely when challenged in upper stretch, dueled inside SON OF A BEAR through the lane and prevailed. SON OF A BEAR brushed with BLACK BELT just after the start, was unhurried while saving ground around the first turn, advanced inside down the backstretch, bid two wide around the far turn to reach near even terms turning for home, battled outside of the winner through the lane and hung. RUMMY'S COMMAND stalked the pace three wide around the first turn, angled to the rail entering the far turn and lacked the needed stretch rally. TOUGH TALKING was devoid of speed while saving ground and rallied belatedly. I JUST DID IT was unhurried along the rail early, advanced along the rail down the backstretch, steadied entering the far turn, swung four wide near the three-sixteenths pole, drifted in and bumped with TAYLOR'S FLIGHT in upper stretch and lacked a rally. TAYLOR'S FLIGHT pressed the pace outside of the winner through the opening half, tired around the far turn, bumped with I JUST DID IT in upper stretch and continued to fade through the lane.
