PLEZE MR PRESIDENT off a step slow then bumped at the start, set the pace inside, held clear under a strong drive. JULES CAESAR bumped at the start, prompted the issue three wide, finished well. NICOLES PROSPECT set the pace on the rail, dug in through the turn, weakened the last sixteenth. WARLOCKED forced the issue three and four wide, lacked a late response. CHIEF OSHKOSH saved ground, rallied five wide around the turn but failed to sustain his bid. SOFIASHUTCHBUSTER saved ground but had no rally. LAST TRIBUTE three and four wide, never threatened. SILVER SPIKE kept six wide, failed to menace. CLOVER CREST made little impact along the inside. IM A TIGGER TOO went to his nose at the start and lost his rider.
