Footnotes

SIX STORMS stalked the pace two wide, tipped three wide near the three-sixteenths pole, rallied outside, was brushed near the sixteenth pole, took command leaving that marker and edged ahead under a drive. SURPRISE ATTACK settled off the pace, raced four wide around the turn, continued on his left lead in the lane, rallied widest and was up for the place on the wire. MY SALTY DOG broke a bit slowly, rushed up to press the pace two wide between foes, was brushed in midstretch and was outfinished between foes in the late stages. MIDNIGHT BOP set a pressured pace along the rail, drifted out and brushed MY SALTY DOG in midstretch and weakened. WESHUPONAKISS saved ground throughout, continued on his left lead and rallied. SPY DUST stalked the pace three wide, continued on his left lead in the lane and lacked a bid. BANC D'OR failed to menace while racing three wide. The Stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run but found no reason to alter the original order of finish.
