DOWN TOWN ALLEN , forwardly placed between rivals into the first turn, took closer order leaving the half mile marker, was shoved along chasing JAX AND JILL around the final turn, leveled off to her best stride entering the stretch, put a head in front a sixteenth out then edged away under solid hand encouragement. JAX AND JILL quickly established a clear advantage, was nursed along in about the two path, responded when set down leaving the far turn, was confronted by the winner in upper stretch, dueled and gave way grudgingly. AUTUMN AFFAIR moved four wide to contention into the first turn, chased the leaders three wide past the three sixteenths marker, kept on willingly but failed to gain. WONT BE DENIED , removed from the inside, failed to make an impact. RUNAWAY BRAE was not a threat. SEVERN SHORE angled off the inside for the backstretch run, raced four wide leaving the quarter pole but failed to make her presence felt. NOTAYANKEEFAN saved ground stalking the early pace and tired.
