SATISFIED MIND exchanged light contact with Crafty Mischief leaving the gate, was well reserved to maintain control through the backstretch, prompted for run into the final turn, lost ground entering the stretch, veered sharply outward making contact with Value Your Angel near the sixteenth pole but dug in from there to edge away when straightened. VALUE YOUR ANGEL stalked the pace the opening half mile, started his drive toward the three eighths pole, was bumped off stride midway through the stretch though remained a close factor to late yards before yielding. ANNA'S FIREBALL settled back toward the outside, started a drive near the quarter pole, lost a significant amount of ground passing the three sixteenths pole and leveled off in the stretch. YOU ARE OUT, five wide the first turn, was kept close through the backstretch, saved ground on the final turn and was no further factor in the lane. CRAFTY MISCHIEF exchanged light contact with Satisfied Mind at the start and put in an even effort. THEWAYOFTHE SAMURAI was not a factor. RUN FAT BOY RUN saved ground though never factored. RED LIGHT stalked the pace from the inside but was through after nine sixteenths. After posting the inquiry, the stewards reviewed a claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of the runner-up, and subsequently disqualified the former for interfering with the latter in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole.
