GUS WHO accelerated to the front, set the pace along the rail, opened up on the turn, was kept to his business in the drive, galloped out lame and was vanned off. EGO'S APPEAL prompted the pace outside the winner in a game effort. TAKEN lacked speed, angled three wide leaving the turn and rallied. NIC'S AMIGO , two wide between horses on the turn, finished willingly. BIG CITY PAT circled the turn three wide, chased the pace to the stretch, drifted in a bit and weakened. LORD DUBAI hugged the rail, passed tired foes and was outrun. JAMAICAN EXPRESS was outrun. REAL DUDE saved ground around the turn and gave way in upper stretch. MACHISMO lost ground around the turn and was outrun. BY YOUR SIDE , unhurried early, was not a factor.
