Footnotes

EBONY angled in around the first turn and rated kindly off of a contested pace, steadily advanced along the rail into the far turn, angled out three to four wide, made a grinding run under left handed pressure and got up in the final jumps. JENNY'S EARTHQUAKE set a pressured pace off the rail, dueled two wide from the furlong pole to deep stretch, finished gamely between foes and just missed. R E LEE forced the pace along the rail, drew on near even terms approaching the stretch and stayed on well. PROPER MOVE angled off the inside leaving the half mile marker, chased three wide around the final turn, did not switch leads until late and came up empty. SKEETER'S CASTLE drifted soon after the break, was taken wide early, remained wide and failed to threaten. TAKE PRIDE PLEASE rushed up four wide into the first turn, forced the issue three wide to the far turn then tired. MOYCULLEN , three wide between rivals early, was done after a half mile. CIVIL RUNNER dwelt at the break and trailed.
