Footnotes

EMMARA GALE gained a good inside position early, commenced a run under urging leaving the far turn, made steady progression along the rail into the lane, took over a sixteenth and held sway under a drive. MISS CHARADES pulled her way clear early, set a solid pace under rating while off the rail, moved away to a lengthy advantage after six furlongs, began getting out leaving the three sixteenths marker, entered the lane five wide, continued to wander outward in the stretch but kept on gamely. PLUNGEINTHEMOAT stalked the early pace while two wide, dropped to the inside giving chase around the final turn then faded. DOMESTIC ROSE was rated back and angled in soon after the break, lagged well back then passed tired rivals. TOMAHAWK TALK was used four around the first turn, chased three wide to the three eighths pole then weakened. ALMOST DAD was outrun. RATTLE AWHILE , wide, was not a threat. ANTHENSOME failed to menace.
