LADY SOPHISTICATE duelled for command early, moved to a long lead but was all out to last. MITOTE MAYA saved ground, rallied three wide around the turn and closed with a rush. SANDERLING pressed the pace just off the rail, finished strongly. ANGELIC GAL forced the pace three and four wide, lacked a late response. T. V. SECRETARY stalked the pace three wide, failed to respond. SHE'S A DEPUTY passed tiring rivals. MARY ANN bid four wide along the backstretch but flattened out. PLUCKY DISCOVERY prompted the pace for three quarters on the rail then had little left for the drive.
