ATTEMPTING REENTRY set a pressured pace two deep on the backstretch, contested between horses rounding the turn and dug in under determined stretch handling to best the runner-up in late yards. POMMETTE pressed the winner while alternating for control on the backstretch, continued gamely through the lane though reluctantly ceded the final yards. MISS RAVALO showed no speed well back inside, bid nearing the quarter pole and just missed place in a strong finish. MAGICAL POINT chased the pace about the four path and finished evenly. BONDI, briefly clear, chased the pace through the backstretch, was at even terms three wide midway on the turn then lost ground weakening entering the stretch. HIGH UP showed no speed well back in the four path and had no significant bid. DANCETILITHUNDERS chased the pace from the inside but had no stretch response. HEIR DE VYE, C U IN THE SPRING and JAYTIVE were all not factors.
