Footnotes

BIG PEACE was hustled along eight wide to take control at the seven sixteenths pole, saved ground nearing the turn, drifted outward under steady left hand pressure, pulled up short after the wire, was unsaddled on the turn and vanned off. SHENANDOAH REBEL engaged in close chase five wide and was gaining steadily on the weakening winner. SPEAKING OF LUCK gave distant chase while saving ground, steadily improved while being eased outward on the turn, entered the stretch about the four path and finished evenly in show. DEVIL HIS SUE gave close chase inside to the head of the lane before leveling off. MOLINARO VALENTINA chased the early pace toward mid track, saved some ground through the turn but proved empty in the stretch. DRUANTIA, evenly off the rail through the backstretch, lost considerable ground through the turn, entered the stretch in the seven path and proved empty in the stretch. OUR SUMMER BREEZE dropped well back early while saving ground. DENALI PASSION dropped back outside from a sharp break, rounded the turn six wide and weakened in the lane. LEXI'S CROWD gave chase off the rail then faded through the turn.
