WON'T BE DENIED chased the pace off the rail, took over past the three sixteenths pole, drew clear through the upper stretch and held well under moderate handling. NISTELTOE chased the pace from the inside, eased three wide leaving the turn and dueled for place. FLIP THE SWITCH gave chase toward mid track, saved some ground on the turn, moved to the outside in the upper stretch and finished evenly widest. AIX EN PROVENCE lacked speed early, steadily improved under a drive from the three eighths pole to late stretch but flattened stride nearing the wire. GOOD LOOKING GIRL chased the pace toward the outside, entered the stretch five wide but proved empty from there. BELLA THE PRINCESS chased the early pace from the outside, saved some ground on the turn then leveled off in the stretch. HOPE FOR A WIN moved to the front while saving ground, showed the way to the middle of the turn then gave way in the stretch. DADDY'S ASHLEY chased the early pace toward mid track then faded nearing the turn.
