Footnotes

SULTRYEYESFORU chased the pace about the three path, dueled to the lead inside the sixteenth pole and edged clear approaching the wire. STORMY COMBO took over to set the pace two deep, drew clear at the quarter pole, was caught in midstretch and leveled off nearing the wire. VIRGINIA PARK chased the pace inside and won the nod in the duel for show. VIVETTE chased the pace inside, eased to the three path leaving the turn but missed the nod in the duel for show. LA KOPPA CHICA gave chase from the three and four paths then leveled off down the lane. ICY LOVER chased the early pace about the three path, eased five wide into the stretch but proved empty from there. COLLEGE STATION moved inward to press the pace inside then weakened from the head of the lane. MADALYN'S CHOICE, well back toward mid track, moved to the outside at the head of the lane and weakened. TRIBECA ROYALTY broke a step slow then steadied on the chute. CITY TALENT was not a factor.
