KIYOSHI pressed the pace just off the rail, made the lead on the turn, drew off through the stretch under a drive. EASTER SUNRISE prompted the issue from the inside and was second best late. TUFF TIGER set the pace on a clear lead, gave way around the turn. NUMERATE three and four wide down the backstretch, bid along the rail on the turn but was no match for the winner in the drive. SEQUINS OF EVENTS off a step slow, found his best stride late, four wide. EAGLE BEAGLE forced the issue three wide, lacked a late response. MINYAN within striking distance along the rail, lacked the needed rally. BROTHER DUDLEY was used up after a half, inside. BOLD DESIGN showed little on the rail. SHENANDOAH SLEW made little impact, four wide.
